

Goodwill is proud to honor Sylvia Trundle as this year's Taste of Vintage Community Service Honoree for her extraordinary leadership, dedication to public service and steadfast support of Goodwill's mission. Her bio reflects a lifetime of commitment to the safety, well-being and vitality of the Greater Akron community.

After twenty-eight years of service, Sylvia retired as Captain from the Akron Police Department in 2017. During her distinguished career, she was a member of SWAT and served in the Patrol, Services and Investigative Sub-Divisions. She also made history as the department's first full-time Police Information Officer. Before joining the Akron Police Department, Sylvia served with the Copley and Fairlawn Police Departments.

Sylvia continues to dedicate her time and expertise through numerous community organizations. She currently serves on the boards of Cleveland Clinic Akron General (Vice Chair), the Conservancy for Cuyahoga Valley National Park and the Summit County ADM (Alcohol, Drug Addiction, Mental Health) Board.

Her previous board service includes Fair Housing Contact Service, Greenleaf Family Services, Victim Assistance Program (Board Chair), Summit County Safety Forces Support Center (Board Chair), OPEN M, Love Akron, United Way of Summit & Medina, AAA Akron (Board Chair), Akron Community Foundation (Board Chair), Women's Endowment Fund, Truly Reaching You and Girls on the Run Northeast Ohio.

In recognition of her service and leadership, Sylvia has received numerous honors, including the Women's Network Woman of Achievement Award (2011), Greenleaf Family Center Betty Dalton Community Service Award (2014), ATHENA Leadership Award (2017), Women's Endowment Fund Judith A. Read Award (2020), Victim Assistance Bernard Rosen Community Service Award (2021), and the Leadership Akron Dave Lieberth Community Vision Award (2024).

Sylvia is a graduate of The University of Akron, the FBI National Academy, Police Executive Leadership College and Leadership Akron Class 25.

A long-time supporter of Goodwill and its mission, Sylvia has graced the Taste of Vintage runway every year since 2012. This year, Goodwill is thrilled to once again celebrate Sylvia — not only as a model but as its 2025 Community Service Honoree!





AUCTION GUIDELINES

Silent Auction Guidelines

- **By Browser:** Go to https://TasteofVintage. givesmart.com on your phone's web browser. In the top right corner of the screen, select **sign in** to log on. Google Chrome is best browser for Android devices.
- Add your credit card. Log in and select My Info tab and follow prompts.
- Place a bid: Select Items tab at the top of the screen. From the items page scroll up and down to access categories and items. Select item and scroll down to place bid or auto bid. To auto bid, enter the highest amount you are willing to bid. The system will place minimum bids for you as needed until you reach your designated amount.

OR

- Bid by text: Text TasteofVintage to 76278 and you will receive a welcome text with a personal bid link.
- **To receive information** on an item, text the item number to **76278**. You will receive a text with the item name and minimum bid amount.
- **To bid:** text item number and bid amount. Example: "102 300" then press send. You will receive a text when a bid is placed as well as when you are outbid.
- Instant Items (purses): text buy and item number to 76278. Example "Buy 1011" then press send.

If you need assistance placing a bid, please see any of the volunteers at the silent auction tables to help you place your bid.

When you bid, you are agreeing to the printed description of the display. Some packages are complete, while others require arrangements to be made to claim them. A bid is a legal contract; bidders are obliged to provide payment information directly on the https://TasteofVintage.givesmart.com website or see a Goodwill representative at the Cash Out Table.

All tables will close at 8:00 p.m. **PLEASE DO NOT REMOVE** YOUR ITEM FROM THE AUCTION TABLE UNTIL YOU HAVE CASHED OUT (see Cash Out at right).

Live Auction Guidelines

- Raise your program, with the bid number facing the auctioneer, to bid on a live auction package.
- An accepted bid is considered a legal contract.
- ALL SALES ARE FINAL. Acceptable payments are Visa, MasterCard, Discover, American Express, cash or check (payable to Goodwill Industries of Akron). No refunds will be given.
- If you win a package, it must be arranged within one
 year, unless specified otherwise. Both parties must
 mutually agree upon the time and place of the package.
 Unless otherwise specified or stated by donor, all items
 are transferable from the winner to another person.
- Unless otherwise stated bidder is responsible for gratuity and beverages.
- In the event of any disputes among bidders, the auctioneer reserves the right to determine the successful bidder.
- The person bidding must be 21 years of age or older.
- All or part of your contribution may be deductible.
 Please consult your tax advisor for guidance about the deductibility of such items based on your individual situation.
- Goodwill Industries staff members will help you claim your items after you have paid for them.

Cash Out

Payment options: cash, check (payable to Goodwill Industries of Akron), Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express. Volunteers at the auction tables and Cash Out table will be available to assist you.

If you are the successful bidder on a package:

 Please be prepared to show that you paid when you claim your item from the table; or
- Go to the Cash Out table to pay for your item, be prepared to give them your auction number to pay and then claim your item.



Work creates the economic energy that builds strong families and communities as well as helps build self-confidence, friendships and independence. Everyone deserves a chance to have those things in life and Goodwill provides that chance through the following services:

- Vocational evaluations to identify job interests, abilities and aptitudes
- Pre-employment testing to determine the skill level and performance match to a variety of occupations
- Youth employment opportunities designed to give at-risk youth a chance to participate in self-sufficiency and employment programs to better ensure success in life
- Skills training in resume preparation, completion of applications and interviewing
- Work experience programs
- Job coaching support

Supporting Mission Services will ensure Goodwill can continue its critical work in our community. Examples of what your financial support can do:

- \$5,000 can provide four high school students with four weeks of high school work experience programming
- \$2,000 can provide two at-risk youth with 10 weeks of employment programs through our Youth Employment Opportunities to Work Program
- \$1,000 can provide four weeks of work experience programming
- \$500 can provide job placement services for one individual
- \$250 can provide 12 hours of situational assessments to allow individuals to experience different jobs
- \$100 can provide the cost of a career assessment for an individual
- \$50 can provide three individuals a bus pass for one week of transportation to receive training and/or job seeking
