Theresa's purpose-driven mission of inspiring volunteerism and empowering others to give back to the community aligns perfectly with Goodwill's mission to help people prepare for, find and retain employment.

A native of Demopolis, Alabama, Theresa graduated from the University of Alabama in 1983 with a Bachelor of Arts in Communications and relocated to Ohio in pursuit of a career in broadcast journalism. However, fate had a different path in store for her. She began her career with General Tire and Rubber Company in 1985, which later became GenCorp, then OMNOVA and now Synthomer. Her entire professional career has been spent with the company, fueling her passion for bringing communities together and creating tomorrow's leaders. The Synthomer Foundation provided nearly \$1.3M in support to educational initiatives, civic investments, health and human services, and the arts in 2021.

Theresa has held several positions in the company since joining in 1985 and will be celebrating her 37th anniversary this year. She began managing

the foundation in the mid-nineties and became president in 2007. Theresa attributes her success to her incredible mom and family who instilled the values she carries to this day. She describes her family as the epitome of servant leaders and has found it very easy to emulate their fantastic examples having experienced them throughout her entire life.

Theresa is active in her church, and serves on several non-profit community boards, advisory councils and committees, including the Akron Community Foundation; The Greater Akron Chamber; The NAACP Akron Chapter; Cleveland Clinic Akron General Medical Center; Cleveland State University Foundation board, and is an emeritus board member with the Akron Urban League. She is also a park commissioner for the Summit County Metro Parks.

She has been honored with many awards and recognitions for her service and commitment to the community, including the Akron Urban League's Whitney M. Young Jr., Community Service Award; the H Peter Burg Leadership Awards through the Greater Akron Chamber, American Red Cross and Akron Public Schools; Leadership Akron's Lieberth Award, and the Executive of the Year Award through the Akron/Canton Affiliate of NSME. Theresa was also a recipient of OMNOVA Solutions Chairman's Award (the Company's highest honor).

Theresa is the proud mom of two amazing and successful adult daughters, Erin and Cesily. She is known as Lovie to her adorable grandson Devon who is the absolute joy of her life.

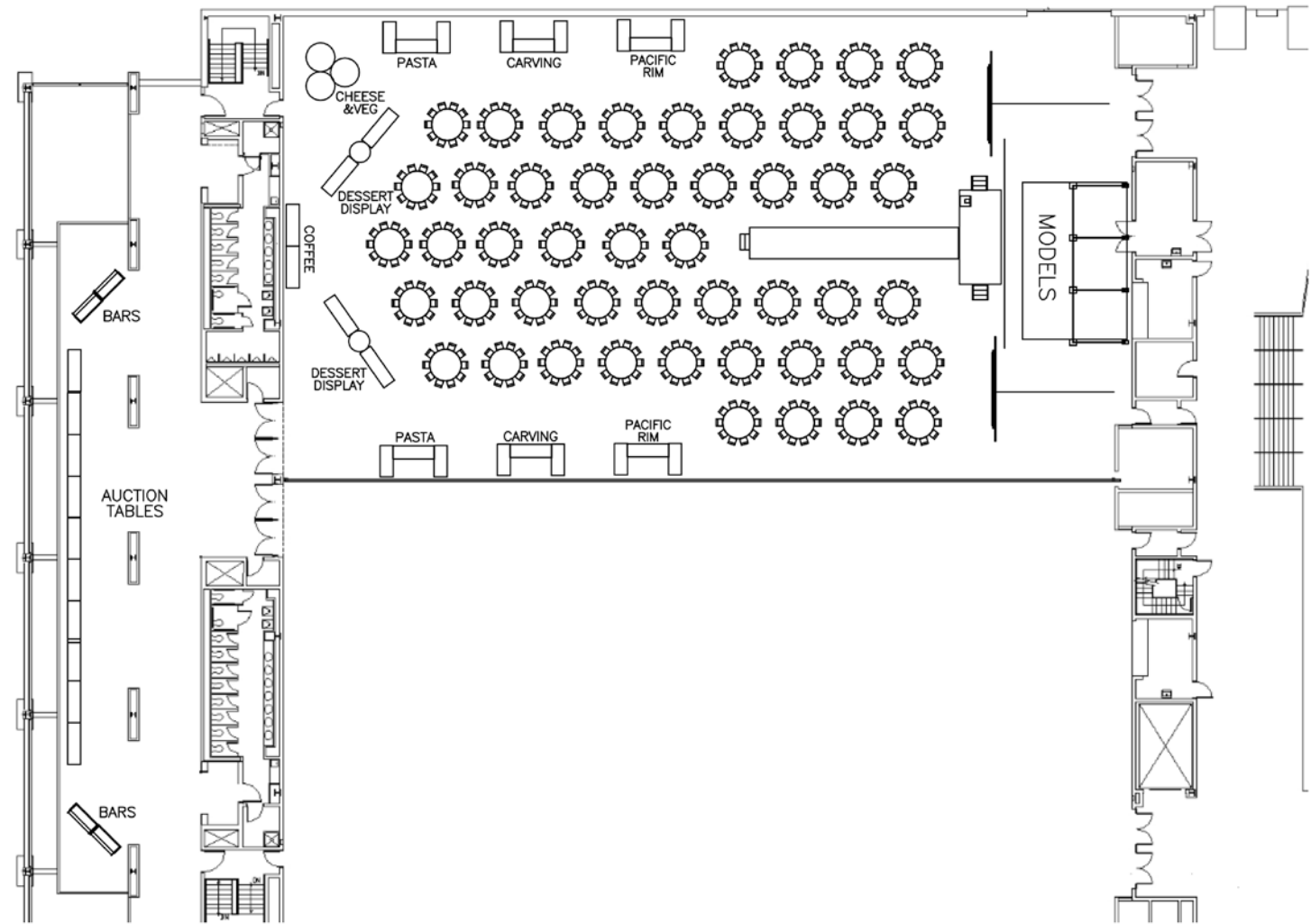
